**Tentative Schedule**: A fisheries sampling workshop (optional) will occur Wednesday morning (0900) at Noxubee National Wildlife Refuge. Scientific presentations and registration will begin Wednesday (1400) at The Mill. A welcome social and poster session will occur Wednesday evening (1800); Thursday (all day) will feature scientific presentations (platform) followed by the banquet dinner; Friday (1000) will conclude with the business meeting.

**CALL FOR ABSTRACTS:** All are invited to submit abstracts for oral presentations and posters describing fisheries research and management of freshwater and marine stocks, conservation efforts of nongame species, aquaculture, and aquatic ecology. Submission deadline for abstracts for both oral and poster presentations is **February 3, 2025**.

Each oral presentation will be 15 minutes (12 minute presentation + 3 minutes for questions). A poster session will be held after the oral presentations and should be 36" X 44", in either landscape or portrait format.
